**Municipal Code Amendment - Weapons on City Owned Property**

Ordinance No. 2571 which declares the possession or presence of firearms or dangerous weapons on various properties owned by the City of Alliance unlawful is before Council on second reading. At our last regular meeting Council approved the first reading of the ordinance to include language recommended by former City Attorney Dobrovolny, Councilman Benzel and Concealed Weapons Instructor Guy Hielscher.
- D. **Ordinance No. 2570 - Third Reading**  
**Homestead Rezoning**

Council has previously conducted a public hearing on the rezoning of property located in the west part of Homestead Addition from RP-5 (Single Family Mobile Home) to R-1A (Single Family Residential) at which time no testimony was offered. Ordinance No. 2570 is now before Council on third reading. The Alliance Planning Commission at their regular meeting, May 8, 2007 recommended approval of the rezoning request. A copy of the staff report, map, and Planning Commission minutes have been made part of the Council packet for your review.
- E. **Ordinance No. 2569 - Third Reading**  
**Municipal Code Amendment - Unarmed Sports Regulations**

Ordinance No. 2569 is before Council on third reading. This Ordinance will amend the Alliance Municipal Code at Chapter 2, Article 11 regarding Unarmed Sports. The Nebraska Legislature has recently passed LB 471, which authorizes the State Athletic Commissioner to regulate mixed martial arts. Former City Attorney Dobrovolny prepared a memorandum for Council's benefit which has been included in the packet, along with a copy of LB 471 and the City's Conditional Use Permit provisions.

F. **Resolution No. 07-84 - Special Designated Liquor License for the Newberry Foundation**

Resolution No. 07-84 has been prepared to approved the Special Designated License Application of the Newberry Foundation for alcohol sales during Heritage Days. Mr. Dennis McCullah is requesting permission to sell beer during Heritage Days July 17, 18, 19, 20, and 21, 2007 at 402 Box Butte Avenue between the hours of 12:00 o'clock noon and 11:00 p.m.

G. **Resolution No. 07-85 - CRP-MAP Contract Extension**

Resolution No. 07-85 will authorize a two year Contract Extension with the Nebraska Game and Parks Commission in cooperation with Pheasants Forever, Inc. and the Nebraska Environmental Trust. The contract allows for walk in hunting to the public on certain properties at the City Well Field. The contract provides for a \$330.00 annual payment to the City of Alliance.
