The family of Bernard and Betty Girard would like to donate a memorial bench for placement near the Central Park fountain. Resolution No. 19-59 will accept the donation.
- D. Resolution No. 19-60 – Donation of Portable Radar Speed Sign Acceptance**  
Resolution No. 19-60 will accept a donation from Panhandle Public Health for a portable radar speed sign. The initial thought is for the sign to be placed on Flack Avenue near the intersection of 10<sup>th</sup> Street to assist in slowing traffic for pedestrian safety. The device would be available for special events, public works projects and law enforcement needs.
- E. Resolution No. 19-61 – Disc Golf Course Upgrade Process**  
This resolution will authorize staff to proceed with the improvements and enhancements to the Rolling Prairie Disc Golf Course this fiscal year by granting budget authority. 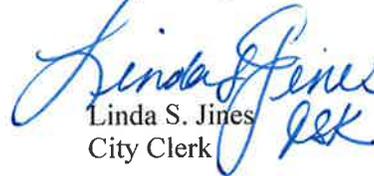
Tina Lulow is no longer eligible to serve on the A-2 Downtown Improvement Board as a result of selling her business; but is eligible to serve on the A-1 Downtown Improvement Board as a result of her employment and would like to fill the remainder of Ms. Johnston's term to 10/31/21.

Chris Mundt has expressed an interest to be appointed to the A-2 Downtown Improvement District for a term expiring 10/31/21. Should this appointment be made, both Downtown Improvement Boards are complete.

Currently there remains two vacancies on the Board of Adjustment, three vacancies on the Economic Development Plan Citizen Advisory Board, one youth representative on the Library Board, one vacancy on the Museum Board, two vacancies on the Park and Tree Board and the alternate position on the Planning Commission.
