- C. Ordinance No. 2900 – First Reading**
Revising Classification Plan
Ordinance No. 2900 is before Council and will amend the current fiscal year Classification Plan by adding a Golf Course Administrator and modifying an existing position due to additional responsibilities. Staff is requesting the waiving of three readings in order to move forward with the hiring process for a Golf Course Administrator.
- D. Ordinance No. 2899 – Second Reading**
Municipal Code Amendment – Right-of-Way Usage Regulations
Ordinance No. 2899 is before Council on second reading and will amend Chapter 24 of the Alliance Municipal Code. This amendment will give the City the ability to regulate the installation of telecommunication lines in our right-of-ways.
- E. Resolution No. 19-108 – Panhandle Mens' Club Donation to the Golf Course**
Resolution No. 19-108 will accept a donation of approximately \$31,000 from the Panhandle Men's Club, Inc. for improvements to the men's locker room and additional storage space for the bar at the clubhouse at SkyView Golf Course.

F. Resolution Nos. 19-109 and 19-110 – Employee Health Insurance Renewal

Resolution No. 19-109 will approve the renewal contracts and rates with Regional Care, Inc. our third party administrator; Sutton our reinsurance carrier; and our other vendors of health services. Resolution 19-110 approves the new premium rates to be paid by employees for calendar year 2020.

G. Resolution No. 19-111 – P25 Radio Purchase

This resolution will authorize the first purchase of a multi-year portable and mobile radio upgrade to P25 compatible radios. This year will be for the Fire Department in the amount of \$121,874.45 utilizing the State Contract from Motorola Solutions. The Alliance Rural Fire Department is also upgrading their radios at this time for compatibility of all equipment.

H. Resolution No. 19-112 – Police Patrol Vehicle Purchase

Resolution No. 19-112 will authorize the purchase of a 2020 Ford F-150 Crew Cab 4x4 Special Service Vehicle from Henderson Ford of Lincoln, NE utilizing the State Contract in the amount of \$32,630. The purchase will also require additional accessories such as radar unit, docking station, and security cage for prisoner transport totaling \$7,000.

I. Resolution No. 19-113 – Community Service Officer Vehicle Purchase

This resolution will approve the purchase of a 2020 Ford F-150 Super Cab 4x4 from Cover Jones Motor Company of Alliance in the amount of \$30,440 with a fiberglass animal carrier topper installation for an additional \$15,180 from an additional vendor.

J. Resolution No. 19-114 – GNL, Inc. Economic Development Assistance Agreement

GNL, Inc. dba Carter Home, Hardware and Appliance has made application for the use of LB840 funding to assist with their business. The Economic Development Plan Application Review Committee met on October 3, 2019 and has recommended approval of the LB840 Application for Carter Home, Hardware and Appliance. Resolution No. 19-114 has been prepared for Council’s consideration and will approve the Agreement that establishes the conditions of funding.

K. Board Announcements

Currently there are vacancies on the Board of Adjustment, A-1 and A-2 Downtown Improvement Boards, Economic Development Plan Citizen Advisory Board, youth representatives on the Library Board, Museum Board, Park and Tree Board and the alternate position on the Planning Commission.
