**C. Ordinance No. 2902 – NDOT Speed Limit Recommendations  
Second Reading**

Staff has received notification from the Nebraska Department of Transportation (NDOT) in regards to existing speed limit zones on Highway 385, Highway 2 and Highway 87. Ordinance No. 2902 is before Council on second reading and will amend Section 26-51 of the Alliance Municipal Code to reflect the recommended changes from the NDOT and will incorporate the updated speed limits within the City.

**D. Resolution No. 20-40 - Amendment to the One & Six Year Street Improvement Plan**

The Alliance City Council on March 3, 2020 approved the One and Six Year Street Improvement plan and authorized submittal to the State of Nebraska. With project costs being higher than anticipated, the Third Street Overlay Project has been postponed. Council has requested staff to modify the Plan to include additional streets due to the delay of Third Street. In order to complete the amended Plan, a budget transfer in the amount of \$1,200,000 from Account No. 24-41-41-51-932 – 3<sup>rd</sup> Street – Howard to Elkhorn to Account No. 24-41-41-44-471 – CNTSVC-Asphalt Street Repairs is required. This will cover the new project costs and engineering fees.

Resolution No. 20-40 will accept and approve the amended One & Six Year Improvement Plan, in addition to, approve the budget transfer in the amount of \$1,200,000 from Account No. 24-41-41-51-932 – 3<sup>rd</sup> Street – Howard to Elkhorn to Account No. 24-41-41-44-471 – CNTSVC-Asphalt Street Repairs.

**Resolution No. 20-41 – Engineering Service Agreement with M.C. Schaff**

Resolution No. 20-41 will approve the Engineering Services Agreement with M.C. Schaff in the amount of \$90,031 which includes civil design, bidding services and construction oversight for the Amended One and Six Year Street Improvement Plan.


