**C. Ordinance No. 2902 – NDOT Speed Limit Recommendations
Third Reading**

Staff has received notification from the Nebraska Department of Transportation (NDOT) in regards to existing speed limit zones on Highway 385, Highway 2 and Highway 87. Ordinance No. 2902 is before Council on third reading and will amend Section 26-51 of the Alliance Municipal Code to reflect the recommended changes from the NDOT and will incorporate the updated speed limits within the City.

D. Resolution No. 20-44 – FAA Grant Submittal Approval

The Alliance Municipal Airport is eligible for grant funding through the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA). The grant is in the amount of \$30,000 and can be used towards any authorized expenses as defined by the FAA. Resolution No. 20-44 will authorize the submittal of the grant application and authorizes the Mayor to sign all associated grant documents once received.

Resolution No. 20-45 – Agency Agreement with Nebraska Department of Transportation Aeronautics Division

Resolution No. 20-45 will authorize the Mayor to sign an Agency Agreement with the Nebraska Department of Transportation Aeronautics Division in order for the Alliance Municipal Airport to receive the CARES Act Grant.


E. Resolution No. 20-46 – Alliance Infrastructure Agency Interlocal Cooperation Agreement
