

- C. Public Hearing on the Proposed 2020-2021 Budget
Ordinance No. 2907 – Second Reading
Appropriations (Budget)**
Now is the date, time and place to conduct a Public Hearing on the proposed 2020-21 Budget. Following the Public Hearing, Council will consider Ordinance No. 2907 for second reading. The proposed budget contains anticipated and estimated revenues and expenses for the next fiscal year.
- D. Ordinance No. 2908 – Second Reading
Additional 1% for Budgeted Restricted Funds**
Ordinance No. 2908 will allow the City of Alliance with a 75% affirmative vote by Council to exceed the Allowable Growth and Basic Allowable Growth for the 2020-21 fiscal year budget by 1%. This does not increase the 2020-21 fiscal year budget; it allows us to increase the unused budget authority for use in future years. Staff is requesting Council consider waiving the three readings of this ordinance.
- E. Ordinance No. 2910 – First Reading
Classification and Compensation Plans**
This Ordinance will adopt the Classification and Compensation Plans which will be incorporated in our 2020-21 Fiscal Year Budget. The Compensation Plan includes three categories: Exempt, Non-Exempt, and Fire Employees. In addition, allows for a 2% cost of living adjustment. All wage adjustments will be made effective October 3, 2020.
- F. Resolution No. 20-86 – Bid Award for Lift Station A Rehabilitation Project**
Resolution No. 20-86 will award the Lift Station A Rehabilitation Project to K.L. Wood & Co. in the amount of \$623,522. The bid tabulation and the Engineer's recommendation is included for Council's review.
