- B. Ordinance No. 2911 – First Reading
Economic Development Plan Amendment**
Ordinance No. 2911 is before Council on first reading and will authorize the amendment to the City of Alliance Economic Development Plan by including businesses that derive their principal source of income from early childhood care and education programs under the City's Economic Development Plan. A Public Hearing will be conducted and the second reading of this ordinance will be at the October 6th City Council meeting.
- C. Ordinance No. 2910 – Third Reading
Classification and Compensation Plans**
This Ordinance will adopt the Classification and Compensation Plans which will be incorporated in our 2020-21 Fiscal Year Budget. The Compensation Plan includes three categories: Exempt, Non-Exempt, and Fire Employees. In addition, allows for a 2% cost of living adjustment. All wage adjustments will be made effective October 3, 2020.
- D. Resolution No. 20-94 – Acceptance of Land O'Lakes Foundation and WESTCO Donation**
David Briggs, General Manager of WESTCO, will be in attendance to present Council with a check in the amount of \$10,000 to be used towards the purchase of body cameras and protective armor for the Alliance Police Department. The WESTCO donation is a match of a \$10,000 grant that was awarded by Land O'Lakes Foundation. Resolution No. 20-94 will accept the donations.
- E. Board Appointments, Resignations and Announcements**
Trish Neely has submitted an application to serve on the Park and Tree Board. If appointed, Ms. Neely's term will expire February 28, 2023.
Caisey Pfeiffer has submitted an application to serve as the High School Student Representative on the Police Advisory Board. If appointed, Ms. Pfeiffer's term will expire July 31, 2021.
