**G. Ordinance No. 2913 – Second Reading**

**Consider and Approve Purchase Agreement with Bulldog, Inc. – Block 1, Wheeler Addition**

Ordinance No. 2913 is before Council on second reading and will authorize the sale of Block 1, Wheeler Addition to the City of Alliance, Box Butte County, Nebraska to Bulldog, Inc. in the amount of \$96,000. The sale has been solicited through an invitation to purchase process, with Bulldog Inc. being the only offer received. Staff recommends a waiver of the three readings due to the protections afforded by publication of the ordinance and a remonstrance opportunity.

**H. Resolution No. 20-106 – Approve the use of ACE Funds for Holiday Decorations**


