The Alliance City Council met in a Special Meeting, November 18, 2020 at 12:00 p.m. in the Conference Room of the Alliance Municipal Building, 324 Laramie Avenue. A notice of meeting was posted at City Hall, Box Butte County and the Alliance Learning Center from November 11, 2020 to November 18, 2020. The notice stated the date, hour and place of the meeting, that the meeting was open to the public, and that an agenda of the meeting, kept continuously current, was available for public inspection at the office of the City Clerk in City Hall; provided the Council could modify the agenda at the meeting if it determined an emergency so required. A similar notice, together with a copy of the agenda, also had been delivered to each of the City Council Members. An agenda, kept continuously current, was available for public inspection at the office of the City Clerk during regular business hours from the publication of the notice to the time of the meeting.

Mayor Dafney opened the November 18, 2020 Special Meeting of the Alliance, Nebraska City Council at 12:00 p.m. Present were Council Members Dafney, Mischnick, Jones, Reynolds, and Bentley. Also present were newly elected Councilmember John McGhehey, Finance Director Waggener, City Clerk Johnson, and Attorney Hoesing.

- The only item on the agenda were the Zoom interviews with potential City Manager candidates.

Mayor Dafney motioned pursuant to Section 84-1410 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska 1943 that the Alliance City Council enter into an executive session for the purpose of conducting Zoom interviews with potential City Manager candidates to protect the reputation of each candidate. The motion was seconded by Councilman Bentley.

Roll call vote with the following results:

Voting Aye: Dafney, Mischnick, Reynolds, Jones, Bentley.

Voting Nay: None.

Motion carried.


November 18, 2020
