- B. Ordinance No. 2927 - Municipal Code Amendment in Regards to Parking Limitations
Second Reading**
Ordinance No. 2927 is before Council on second reading and will amend the Alliance Municipal Code within Chapter 26, Article V to provide for a more efficient and straight-forward parking code.
- C. Ordinance No. 2928 – Municipal Code Amendment – Publicly Shared Scooters and Transport
First Reading**
The City has received a request from Bird Rides, Inc. to expand their scooter sharing business in Alliance. Ordinance No. 2928 is before Council on first reading and will amend the Alliance Municipal Code to include the use of scooters, bicycles, and other modes of transportation within the City's Right-of-Way. A Memorandum of Understanding has been included for Council's review which documents both the City's and Bird Rides, Inc. expectations if Council desires to move forward with the code amendment. The Memorandum of Understanding will not be approved until adoption of the ordinance.
- D. Ordinance No. 2929 – Classification Plan Modification
First Reading**
Ordinance No. 2929 is before Council on first reading and will amend the 2021-22 Classification Plan to include an Executive Administrative Assistant/Tourism position; in addition, modify the title of Outreach Services at the library to Technical Services Librarian. These changes will become effective the first payroll following adoption of the ordinance.
