**C. Ordinance No. 2943 – FY 21-22 Classification Plan Adoption Process Amendment
Resolution No. 22-31 – FY 21-22 Classification Plan Amendments**

Ordinance No. 2943 is before Council on first reading and will authorize amendments to the adopted FY 21-22 Classification Plan be completed via resolution. Staff is requesting the waiving of the statutory requirement of three readings in order to streamline the advertising of vacant positions.

Resolution No. 22-31 authorizes changes to the FY 21-22 Classification Plan as a result of the retirement of Finance Director Waggener by incorporating a City Treasurer and Utility Services Office Manager within the classification plan.

D. Ordinance No. 2942 – Alliance Municipal Code Chapter 22 Code Amendments

Ordinance No. 2942 is on second reading and addresses a number of issues previously presented by the offense code, incorporates existing portions of the offense code, and introduces a number of ordinance offenses that are commonly found in other cities of the first class.

E. Ordinance No. 2937 – Dissolution of the A-1 Downtown Business Improvement District

Ordinance No. 2937 is before Council on third reading and will amend Code by removing the A-1 Downtown Improvement District Board.

F. Ordinance No. 2938 - Dissolution of the A-2 Downtown Business Improvement District

Ordinance No. 2938 is before Council on third reading and will amend Code by removing the A-2 Downtown Improvement District Board.

G. Resolution No. 22-32 – Interim Airport Project Financing

Resolution No. 22-32 will authorize an inter-department loan of up to \$500,000 from the Electric Fund to the Airport Fund for one year at the rate of 2.00% for the City's responsibility of 10% of the overall costs of the taxiway and apron rehabilitation project at the airport.
