B. Certified Election Results

The City of Alliance is in receipt of the Certified Election Results from the May 11, 2010 Primary Election. Cheryl McDuffie, Box Butte County Clerk/Election Commissioner certified 522 votes were cast in favor of Proposition #1 and 472 votes against. As a result of this vote, the City of Alliance will not be required to add fluoride to the municipal water supply if the naturally occurring fluoride drops below the State mandated levels.

**C. Request of Box Butte Public Transit
Ordinance No. 2662 – First Reading
Municipal Code Amendment – Parking Regulations**

Judy Price, Director of the Box Butte County Public Transit is requesting the City designate a parking area for their buses in the downtown area between the hours of 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday. The original request was for two parking spaces on the south side of 4th Street, west of Box Butte Avenue (next to the vacant lot). Staff reviewed the request and had a bus come to the site for a trial run. Following the review, staff is proposing the use of the two spaces closest to the alley which will allow adequate parking without a great deal of maneuvering and provide for the safe loading and unloading of wheelchair patrons. Ordinance No. 2662 has been prepared for Council's consideration on first reading and includes language adopting staff's revision to the request. If approved, signage will be required.

D. Resolution No. 10-74 – Fireworks Request of the Alliance Jaycees

The Alliance Jaycees are requesting permission to conduct a fireworks display following the sun setting on Friday, August 13, 2010 in honor of the Grand Opening of the Veteran's Cemetery. The fireworks will be discharged on airport property which has been approved by the FAA and NDA as long as the airport is closed during the display. Fire Chief Shoemaker has outlined the request for Council in a memorandum which is made part of your packet. Resolution No. 10-74 has been prepared for Council's consideration and will grant permission of the request contingent upon receipt of the appropriate Certificate of Insurance at least five days prior to the event.

E. Resolution No. 10-75 – NDEQ Grant Funds & Clarification of Grant for Tire Amnesty Days

Resolution No. 10-75 will authorize staff to accept a grant award in the amount of \$36,552.63 from the Nebraska Department of Environmental Quality. The grant will be used towards the acceptance and disposal of tires at the Alliance Landfill between September 27 and October 2, 2010. Tires will be accepted at no charge from individuals in the County up to the value of the grant award. Tire retailers or businesses that have charged or collected fees to accept scrap tires are not eligible to bring in scrap tires for disposal at the grant-funded scrap tire cleanup.

F. Board Appointments

The City of Alliance is in receipt of a letter from the Panhandle Men’s Club, Inc. stating their representative on the Golf Advisory Board will be their new president, Lannie Shelmadine. No action is required by Council on this notification.

Patricia Ann Howell has provided a request to be re-appointed to the Museum Board for an additional term which will expire May 31, 2015. A copy of her Information Sheet is included in the packet for Council’s review.
