Municipal Code Amendment – Fireworks**

Ordinance No. 2743 is before Council on third reading and will amend the Alliance Municipal Code with regard to fireworks. The ordinance limits discharging between June 25 and July 4, and addresses unsafe or dangerous discharging.
- E. Resolution No. 13-119 – Depository Agreements**

The City of Alliance has received requests from Bank of the West, Farmers State Bank, First National Bank North Platte, Great Western Bank, Nebraska Public Agency Investment Trust, Sandhills State Bank, State Farm Bank and Wells Fargo Bank, to be depositories for the City of Alliance. Sandhills State Bank is an addition this year as a result of their conversion to a full-service bank in Alliance. Resolution No. 13-119 will approve these institutions as the City's authorized depositories.
