The Alliance City Council met in a Special Meeting, February 22, 2017 at 4:00 p.m. in the Video Conferencing Room, 1604 Sweetwater Avenue. A notice of meeting was published in the Alliance Times Herald on February 18, 2017. The notice stated the date, hour and place of the meeting, that the meeting was open to the public, and that an agenda of the meeting, kept continuously current, was available for public inspection at the office of the City Clerk in City Hall; provided the Council could modify the agenda at the meeting if it determined an emergency so required. A similar notice, together with a copy of the agenda, also had been delivered to each of the City Council Members. An agenda, kept continuously current, was available for public inspection at the office of the City Clerk during regular business hours from the publication of the notice to the time of the meeting.

Mayor Yeager opened the February 22, 2017 Special Meeting of the Alliance, Nebraska City Council at 4:04 p.m. Present were Council members Yeager, Korber-Gonzalez, Jones, Mischnick and Reynolds. Also present were Interim City Manager Kuckkahn, City Attorney Olsen and City Clerk Jines.

- Mayor Yeager read the Open Meetings Act Announcement.
- The only item on Council’s agenda was an Executive Session to discuss a personnel matter.

Councilman Jones motioned pursuant to Section 84-1410 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska 1943 that the Alliance City Council hold a closed session for the purpose of a personnel matter to interview potential City Manager candidates and that along with Council, Interim City Manager Kuckkahn, City Attorney Olsen and City Clerk Jines be in attendance. The motion was seconded by Councilman Mischnick.

Roll call vote with the following results:

Voting Aye: Jones, Yeager, Reynolds, Korber-Gonzalez, Mischnick.

Voting Nay: None.

Motion carried.


The closed session began at 4:13 p.m. and ended at 6:42 p.m. No additional action was taken.
