



# Contractor Trailer Parking Permit Application

## NOTICE

- Contractor Trailer Parking Permits are required for the parking of trailers on City streets for periods greater than 72 hours. Contractor Parking Permits are allowed for trailers used by landscaping, electrical, construction, and building contractors performing work that does not require a Building Permit.
- A trailer parking permit will not be required if a valid building permit has been issued for the property. The trailer must be removed after the completion of the work or at the expiration of the Building Permit.
- Any trailer, regardless of permitted status, may be required to move from its location should the City find the trailer obstructs or interferes with driveway and vision requirements or normal use of the roadway.
- Permits expire April 30<sup>th</sup> of each year and will require submittal of a new application and fee.
- The permit decal must be affixed in a conspicuous place on the rear of the trailer. The decal must be removed upon sale of the trailer.
