The Alliance City Council met in a Speical Meeting, August 08, 2023 at 7:00 p.m. in the Alliance Learning Center Community Meeting Room, 1750 Sweetwater Avenue. A notice of meeting was posted at the Alliance Learning Center, Alliance Municipal Building, and Box Butte County Court House on August 04, 2023. The notice stated the date, hour and place of the meeting, that the meeting was open to the public, and that an agenda of the meeting, kept continuously current, was available for public inspection at the office of the City Clerk in City Hall; provided the Council could modify the agenda at the meeting if it determined an emergency so required. A similar notice, together with a copy of the agenda, also had been provided to each of the City Council Members. An agenda, kept continuously current, was available for public inspection at the office of the City Clerk during regular business hours from the publication of the notice to the time of the meeting.

Mayor Jones opened the August 08, 2023 special meeting of the Alliance, Nebraska City Council at 7:00 p.m. Present were Mayor Jones, Vice Mayor McGhehey and Council Members Mischnick, Andersen, and Mashburn. Also present were City Manager Sorensen and City Clerk Pitt.

- Mayor Jones read the Open Meetings Act Announcement.
- The first item on Council’s agenda was Resolution 23-60 which will accept and award Werner Construction, Hastings, Nebraska, the bid of the Alliance Pavement Rehabilitation Project Schedule 2, in the total amount of \$385,985.00. The following information was provide:

[A bid opening was held on August 4, 2023 for the Schedule 2 Pavement Rehabilitation Project. The project was advertised for four (4) weeks prior to the bid opening, which meets the City’s requirements for notification. Three general contractors received plans and specifications prior to the bid opening. Two contractor submitted a bid on the project, with Werner Construction, Hasting, Nebraska, coming in with the lowest bid of \$385,985.00.

RECOMMENDATION: APPROVE RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT AND AWARD THE BID OF THE ALLIANCE PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROJECT SCHEDULE 2 TO WERNER CONSTRUCTION, HASTINGS, NEBRASKA.]

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A motion was made by Councilmen Andersen, seconded by Vice-Mayor McGhehey to approve the Resolution 23-60 which accept and award Werner Construction, Hastings, Nebraska, the bid of the Alliance Pavement Rehabilitation Project Schedule 2, in the total amount of \$385,985.00, which follows in its entirety:

RESOLUTION NO. 23-60

WHEREAS, The City has determined that streets in the City of Alliance should be improved by bituminous overlay and miscellaneous concrete repairs; and

WHEREAS, M.C. Schaff and Associates, an engineering firm for the City, has let bids for the 2023 Alliance Pavement Rehabilitation Project - Schedule 2 with two bids being received; and

WHEREAS, M.C. Schaff and Associates recommends that the City award the bid to Werner Construction., Hastings, Nebraska, in the amount of Three Hundred Eighty-Five Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Five and 00/100ths Dollars, (\$385,985.00) as the lowest, responsive, and responsible bidder for Schedule 2 Street Rehabilitation Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Mayor and City Council of Alliance, Nebraska, that the Mayor is authorized to sign a contract with Werner Construction, Hastings, Nebraska, for the Schedule 2 - Alliance Pavement Rehabilitation Project, as the lowest, responsive and responsible bidder obtained by M.C. Schaff and Associates.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the contract for asphalt overlay as specifically set forth in the bidding documents, is hereby awarded to Werner Construction in the total amount of Three Hundred Eighty-Five Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Five and 00/100ths Dollars, (\$385,985.00) and will be paid from Account No. 24-41-41-51-930.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, Staff shall contact the successful bidder so that contractual arrangements can be finalized, and work can commence according to the terms of the bid.


