C. Ordinance No. 2964 – 2023/2024 Budget Appropriation

Ordinance No. 2964 is on third reading, which presents to Council the proposed 2023/2024 proposed budget beginning October 1, 2023. The proposed budget contains anticipated and estimated revenues and expenses for the next fiscal year.

The Alliance City Council met in a Regular Meeting, September 5, 2023 at 7:00 p.m. in the Alliance Learning Center Community Meeting Room, 1750 Sweetwater Avenue. A notice of meeting was published in the Alliance Times Herald on August 30, 2023. The notice stated the date, hour and place of the meeting, that the meeting was open to the public, and that an agenda of the meeting, kept continuously current, was available for public inspection at the office of the City Clerk in City Hall; provided the Council could modify the agenda at the meeting if it determined an emergency so required. A similar notice, together with a copy of the agenda, also had been provided to each of the City Council Members. An agenda, kept continuously current, was available for public inspection at the office of the City Clerk during regular business hours from the publication of the notice to the time of the meeting.

Mayor Jones opened the September 5, 2023 regular meeting of the Alliance, Nebraska City Council at 7:00 p.m. Present were Mayor Jones, Vice Mayor McGhehey and Council Members Mischnick, Andersen, and Mashburn. Also present were City Manager Sorensen, City Treasurer Baker, City Attorney Hoelsing and City Clerk Pitt.

- Mayor Jones read the Open Meetings Act Announcement.
- The Consent Calendar was the first item on the agenda. A motion was made by Councilman Mashburn, which was seconded by Councilman Mischnick to approve the Consent Calendar as follows:

- The next item on Council's agenda was the second reading of Ordinance No. 2964 – 2023/2024 Budget Appropriation. The following information was provide:

[The 2023/2024 proposed budget is on second reading, which contains the anticipated and estimated revenues and expenses for the next fiscal year.

RECCOMENDATION: APPROVE THE 2023/2024 BUDGET APPROPRIATION.]

Mayor Jones asked if there was any discussion on Ordinance No. 2964.

Councilman Mashburn made a motion to amend Ordinance No. 2964 to reflect a 6% Cost of Living Increase, which was seconded by Councilman Mischnick.

Vice Mayor McGhehey stressed that only 6% percent would be inadequate due to the rising cost of everything, and the impact it is having on everyone.

Councilman Mischnick and Andersen agreed with the 6% COLA and using the remaining budget to help retain positions within the City.

September 5, 2023

Vice Mayor McGhehey expressed great concern about only giving our current employees a 6% COLA, and using the remaining funds to retain employees when our current employees have been picking up the slack because the City has not been able to retain employees.

Councilman Andersen suggested a bonus for the Police Department, Attorney Hoelsing advised that is not doable.

Vice Mayor McGhehey states that he is concerned about our employees now, and not giving them the “bonus” of the full 7% COLA that they deserve.

Roll call vote with the following results:

Voting Aye: Mischnick, Andersen and Mashburn.

Voting Nay: Jones and McGhehey.

Motion carried

Board Member Mischnick made a motion for the remaining 1% of funds that was budgeted for COLA be rolled into Council Contingency and later used as a program approved by City Council for employee retention and employment, which was seconded by Board Member Andersen.

Roll call vote with the following results:

Voting Aye: Jones, Mischnick, McGhehey, Andersen and Mashburn.

Voting Nay: None.

Motion carried.

A motion was made by Vice Mayor McGhehey, seconded by Councilmen Mischnick to approve Ordinance No. 2964 on second reading which approves the proposed 2023/2024 Budget appropriation, which follows in its entirety:

ORDINANCE NO. 2964

AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT THE BUDGET STATEMENT TO BE TERMED THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2023; TO APPROPRIATE SUMS FOR NECESSARY EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLIANCE, NEBRASKA:

September 5, 2023

Section 1: The City Manager, in accordance with the requirements of Nebraska Revised Statute § 19-646, has submitted a proposed budget statement to the City Council, which statement is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference (the "Budget Statement").

Section 2. A public hearing will be held on the Budget Statement in accordance with the requirements of Nebraska Revised Statute § 13-506. Before the final passage and approval of this Ordinance, the Budget Statement may be amended in accordance with comments received at the public hearing, the property valuations provided by Box Butte County, any action to exceed the allowable growth for restricted funds as determined by law, and as necessary to adjust for any other information gathered by the City before October 1, 2023.

Section 3. In accordance with the requirements of the Nebraska Budget Act and Nebraska Revised Statute § 16-704, the amounts set forth in the attached and incorporated Budget Statement shall be and are hereby recognized as the budget appropriations for the City of Alliance, Nebraska for the fiscal year 2023-2024. The fund descriptions and amounts are as follows:

Section 4. Upon final passage and approval of this Ordinance, the Budget Statement is adopted by the City of Alliance Nebraska as the adopted budget statement. A copy of the Budget Statement shall be forwarded as provided by law to the Auditor of Public Accounts, State Capitol, Lincoln, Nebraska, and to the County Clerk of Box Butte County, Nebraska, for use by the levying authority.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall become effective October 1, 2023.

- The next item on the agenda was the first reading of Ordinance No. 2965 which will allow the City of Alliance with a 75% affirmative vote by Council to exceed the Allowable Growth and Basic Allowable Growth for the 2023-24 Fiscal Year Budget by 1%. This does not increase the 2023-24 Fiscal Year Budget; it allows us to increase the unused budget authority for use in the future years.

A motion was made by Councilman Andersen, which was seconded by Councilman Mischnick to approve Ordinance 2965 on first reading which allows the City of Alliance with a 75% affirmative vote by Council to exceed the Allowable Growth and Basic Allowable Growth for the 2023-24 Fiscal Year Budget by 1%, which follows in its entirety.

ORDINANCE NO. 2965

AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING FOR EXCEEDING THE ALLOWABLE GROWTH AND BASIC ALLOWABLE GROWTH LIMITS FOR THE 2023-2024 FISCAL YEAR BY ONE PERCENT OF BUDGETED RESTRICTED FUNDS, AND CORRECTING THE ADOPTED BUDGET STATEMENT AND ACCOMPANYING FORMS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLIANCE, NEBRASKA:

SECTION 1. Governmental units are authorized pursuant to State law at Chapter 13, Section 519, to exceed the Allowable Growth (§13-518(1)) and the Basic Allowable Growth (§77-3446) for budgeted restricted funds authority up to an additional one percent, by affirmative vote of the City Council of at least 75%.

SECTION 2. The City Council finds that such limit as provided by Section 13-519 (a) and (b) should be exceeded by one percent.

September 5, 2023

SECTION 3. An affirmative vote of at least 75% in favor of this increase is hereby cast.

SECTION 4. Section 13-511 allows correction of an adopted budget statement for clerical, mathematical, and accounting errors, which correction does not affect the total amount budgeted by more than one percent or increase the amount required from property taxes. The one percent limit increase is calculated into the current budget statement; however the unused budget authority amount is in need of modification.

SECTION 5. The allowable increase in “restricted funds authority” with the additional one percent of \$80,795.08 and included in the resulting “total restricted funds authority” in the adopted budget ordinance is hereby amended to the amount of \$8,352,975.44.

SECTION 6. Those portions of the existing budget ordinance for 2023-2024 are amended accordingly.

SECTION 7. The City Treasurer is authorized to make appropriate changes in the submitted forms for computation of the limit for fiscal year 2023-2024, and transmit those changes to the State Auditor’s office.

SECTION 8. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval, passage, and publication according to law.

● The final item on the agenda was Resolution No. 23-67 which will accept and award Twin City Roofing and Sheet Metal, Inc., the Landfill Facilities 2021 Hail Storm Repair Project, the total amount \$157,292.98. The following information was provided:

[Bids were received and opened at 2:00 p.m. on August 22, 2023, at the Alliance City Hall Alliance, Nebraska, for the above-referenced project. One company picked up plans for the project:

Twin City Roofing & Sheet Metal, Inc.

There was one minor discrepancy in the bid total. Item A9, Remove and Replace Metal Outside Corner Post total bid price had a rounding error of \$0.01. The total bid price had an error stating that it was \$242.47 while a unit price of \$9.15/LF at 26.5 LF should total \$242.48. The discrepancy was noted on the bid tab and the contract will be adjusted accordingly.

It should be noted that it is not uncommon to have a single bidder on these types of projects. Due to the heavy work load of contractors at this time as well as the state statute that all contractors on government contracts over \$20,000 must carry bonds, it limits the number of contractors that are eligible. Twin City Roofing has been selected on similar projects for both the City of Alliance and other communities in the region and has performed very well with minimal disruptions.

The Engineer's Estimate was based upon the insurance adjuster's estimate. We have reviewed the contractor's bid documents and would recommend award of the project to Twin City Roofing & Sheet Metal in the amount of \$157,292.98.

RECCOMENDATION: APPROVE RESOLUTION NO. 23-67.]

Councilmember Andersen made the motion, seconded by Councilmen Mischnick to amend the Resolution to reflect the \$.01 difference that was noted by M.C. Schaff.

A motion was made by Council Member Mischnick, which was seconded by Vice Mayor McGhehey to approve Resolution No. 23-67 which will accept and award Twin City Roofing and Sheet Metal, Inc., the Landfill Facilities 2021 Hail Storm Repair Project, the total amount \$157,292.98, which follows in its entirety:

RESOLUTION NO. 23-67

WHEREAS, The City has determined that damages from the 2021 hail storm at the Landfill Facilities are in need of repair; and

WHEREAS, M.C. Schaff and Associates, an engineering firm for the City, has let bids for the Alliance Landfill Facilities 2021 Hail Damage Repair with one bid being received; and

WHEREAS, M.C. Schaff and Associates recommends that the City award Schedule C of the bid to Twin City Roofing & Sheet Metal, Inc., of Scottsbluff, Nebraska, in the amount of One Hundred Fifty-Seven Thousand Two Hundred Ninety-Two Dollars and 98/100ths (\$157,292.98) as the lowest, responsive, and responsible bidder for the Landfill Facilities 2021 Hail Damage Repair.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Mayor and City Council of Alliance, Nebraska, that the Mayor is authorized to sign a contract with Twin City Roofing & Sheet Metal, Inc., as the lowest, responsive and responsible bidder obtained by M.C. Schaff and Associates.

September 5, 2023

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the contract for the hail storm repairs as specifically set forth in the bidding documents, is hereby awarded to Twin City Roofing & Sheet Metal, Inc., of Scottsbluff, Nebraska, in the amount One Hundred Fifty-Seven Thousand Two Hundred Ninety-Two Dollars and 98/100ths (\$157,292.98).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, Staff shall contact the successful bidder so that contractual arrangements can be finalized, and work can commence according to the terms of the bid.

Budget Hearing Narrative

Since the first reading of the budget ordinance, the following changes have occurred: we have received property valuations, we have received preliminary healthcare estimates, COLA was adjusted from 8%/4% to a 7%/7% split and then adjusted to a 6%/6% split; removal of the third human resources position, changes to FAA planned projects and carryover amounts, and carryover projects from the current fiscal year were included.

The submitted overall budget ordinance in front of Council today is \$56,319,430; with internal transfers and expenditures, the total amount of dollars to be approved is \$64,691,925.

It is estimated that the property tax levy will decrease from approximately 0.343878 per \$100 of assessed value for the 2022 tax year to approximately 0.307121 per \$100 of assessed value for the 2023 tax year which equates to a tax request of \$1,930,009.

Budgeting was completed utilizing the "Zero-Based" budget method wherein all line items are reset to zero with departments identifying specific items to be included. Market-specific volatility items, such as oil, gas, plastics, chemicals, etc. were based on last year's numbers with an estimated increase for inflation. Included in this amount are projects related to the State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (Coronavirus funding from the federal government) of approximately \$256,400, substantial investments in the local electric grid and work on the mothballed power plant, roadway projects totaling nearly \$1.6 million, and the potential for grant projects related to the 2021 Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act.

This year's budget includes enterprise fee transfers to the general fund at a 12% rate of budgeted enterprise fee revenue. These transfers are performed in-lieu of charging a right-of-way usage charge. This source will provide approximately \$2.71 million toward the general fund operations. This includes planned transfers of:

- \$1,750,000 from the electric fund
- \$420,000 from the water fund
- \$360,000 from the refuse fund,
- \$180,000 from the sewer fund.

City employee salaries are budgeted with an 6% cost-of-living adjustment for hourly employees, 6% cost-of-living adjustment for salaried employees and 3.25% increase for Police and Dispatch as per the most recent FOP contract. Authorized strength will be a net increase of 0.6 FTE from the prior year with authorized strength at 114.26 full-time equivalents, not including season employees. Total cost of pay plus benefits for all employees, including summer hires, is estimated to be \$10,385,874.

The submitted budget includes capital projects of \$11 million. Primary city-wide projects include approximately:

- \$692,000 for airport apron and taxiway overlay (carryover from FY22-23)
- \$1,056,000 for Airport Runway 12/30 seal coat
- \$500,000 for Airport MALSR
- \$2,100,000 for storm damage repair (covered primarily by insurance reimbursement)
- \$1,650,000 for asphalt overlay projects (funded by debt issuance and reserves)
- \$535,000 for warehouse engineering and lease
- \$1,100,000 for grant projects related to streets and parks
- \$300,000 for city hall ADA upgrades design (carryover from FY22-23)
- \$300,000 for purchase of a new ambulance

Enterprise capital projects include approximately \$6.09 million with the following major investments:

- \$2,500,000 for electric urban and rural line rebuilds
- \$1,000,000 for power plant asbestos abatement
- \$670,000 in water treatment and line upgrades
- \$700,000 for landfill repairs and new scale
- \$250,000 for purchase of a new trash truck
- \$240,000 for a new landfill restroom
- \$165,000 for lift station improvements
- \$500,000 for purchase of remote read water meters

Section 1: The City Manager, in accordance with the requirements of Nebraska Revised Statute § 19-646, has submitted a proposed budget statement to the City Council, which statement is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference (the “Budget Statement”).

Section 2. A public hearing will be held on the Budget Statement in accordance with the requirements of Nebraska Revised Statute § 13-506. Before the final passage and approval of this Ordinance, the Budget Statement may be amended in accordance with comments received at the public hearing, the property valuations provided by Box Butte County, any action to exceed the allowable growth for restricted funds as determined by law, and as necessary to adjust for any other information gathered by the City before October 1, 2023.

Section 3. In accordance with the requirements of the Nebraska Budget Act and Nebraska Revised Statute § 16-704, the amounts set forth in the attached and incorporated Budget Statement shall be and are hereby recognized as the budget appropriations for the City of Alliance, Nebraska for the fiscal year 2023-2024. ORDINANCE NO. 2965

AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING FOR EXCEEDING THE ALLOWABLE GROWTH AND BASIC ALLOWABLE GROWTH LIMITS FOR THE 2023-2024 FISCAL YEAR BY ONE PERCENT OF BUDGETED RESTRICTED FUNDS, AND CORRECTING THE ADOPTED BUDGET STATEMENT AND ACCOMPANYING FORMS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLIANCE, NEBRASKA:

SECTION 1. Governmental units are authorized pursuant to State law at Chapter 13, Section 519, to exceed the Allowable Growth (§13-518(1)) and the Basic Allowable Growth (§77-3446) for budgeted restricted funds authority up to an additional one percent, by affirmative vote of the City Council of at least 75%.

SECTION 2. The City Council finds that such limit as provided by Section 13-519 (a) and (b) should be exceeded by one percent.

SECTION 3. An affirmative vote of at least 75% in favor of this increase is hereby cast.

SECTION 4. Section 13-511 allows correction of an adopted budget statement for clerical, mathematical, and accounting errors, which correction does not affect the total amount budgeted by more than one percent or increase the amount required from property taxes. The one percent limit increase is calculated into the current budget statement; however the unused budget authority amount is in need of modification.

SECTION 5. The allowable increase in “restricted funds authority” with the additional 1% of \$80,795.08 and included in the resulting “total restricted funds authority” in the adopted budget ordinance is hereby amended to the amount of \$8,352,975.44.

SECTION 6. Those portions of the existing budget ordinance for 2023-2024 are amended accordingly.

SECTION 7. The City Treasurer is authorized to make appropriate changes in the submitted forms for computation of the limit for fiscal year 2023-2024, and transmit those changes to the State Auditor’s office.

SECTION 8. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval, passage, and publication according to law.

ORDINANCE - PURCHASE AGREEMENT FOR LOTS 3 AND 4, BLOCK 4, HOMESTEAD ADDITION

City Attorney Hoelsing has prepared on behalf of Tierra Vogel an Agreement for Sale of Real Estate for Lots 3 and 4, Block 4, Homestead Addition to the City of Alliance, Box Butte County, Nebraska, in the amount of \$7,700; of which \$2,000 per lot would be eligible for a refund if a residence were constructed within two years of the purchase date.

Resolution No. 07-23 approved by Council on February 15, 2007 established a Uniform Pricing Schedule for the sale of residential properties held by the City. The proposed Agreement for Sale is based on the prices established in the Resolution.

As with any sale of property by the City of Alliance there is a 30-day remonstrance period as established within State Statutes.

AGREEMENT

This Agreement is made on September 5, 2023, between the City of Alliance, Nebraska (the “Seller”) and Tierra Vogel (the “Buyer” whether one or more).

Recitals:

a. The Seller is the owner of the following described real estate along with all permanent improvements (the “Real Estate”):

Lots 3 and 4, Block 4, Homestead Addition to the City of Alliance, Box Butte County, Nebraska.

b. The Seller desires to sell and the Buyer desires to purchase the Real Estate according to the terms of this Agreement.

Agreement:

1. Purchase Price:

a. The “Purchase Price” shall be Seven Thousand Seven Hundred and No/100s (\$7,700) payable as follows: (1) \$500 shall be due and payable to Kunzman Title upon the execution of this Agreement as an Earnest Money Deposit; and (2) the balance of the Purchase Price shall be due in cash or the equivalent at Closing.

b. This Agreement and the closing of the Agreement is also contingent upon: (1) the City Council for the City passing an ordinance authorizing conveyance of title to the Real Estate pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 16-202; (2) the City publishing notice of the conveyance of the Real Estate, and the terms thereof, for three consecutive weeks after final passage and publication of the ordinance authorizing conveyance of the Real Estate, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 16-202; (3) within thirty days after the passage and publication of the ordinance authorizing conveyance of the Real Estate, there is not a valid and successful remonstrance petition against such conveyance, as defined by Neb. Rev. Stat. § 16-202; and (4) reception of a title insurance commitment binder showing good and marketable title as provided in paragraph 3 below.

2. Closing and Possession:

The “Closing” shall take place on or about 90 days after the final publication of the ordinance as described in paragraph 1.b above. At Closing, the Seller shall deliver to the Buyer a Warranty Deed for the Real Estate. Possession shall be delivered to the Buyer as of Closing.

3. Evidence of Title:

Within 20 days of the execution of this Agreement, the Seller shall furnish to the Buyer a title insurance commitment binder, showing good and marketable title to the real estate. Seller shall remove or remedy any defects in title shown on the insurance commitment binder. If it is impossible to remove or remedy any such defects or if title defects exist which will require court action or an unreasonable expense or time to cure, the Seller shall have the unilateral option to terminate and rescind this Agreement in writing and to return the Earnest Money Deposit to the Buyer at that time. Seller represents that there is no lien against the real estate above described for City of Alliance special assessments, and that payment of the Purchase Price at Closing shall extinguish any such special assessments if they do exist. There may be liens for general real estate taxes or other liens, either recorded or unrecorded, and Buyer assumes and agrees to pay any and all of such unpaid real estate taxes and to take the property in an “as is” condition as to the physical real estate.

4. Taxes:

The Seller shall pay all general real estate taxes, if any, levied against the Real Estate for all years prior to the year of the Closing. Any general real estate taxes for the year of the Closing (2023), if any, shall be prorated between the parties to date of the Closing, based on the most recent tax statement available.

5. Risk of Loss:

Risk of loss for all improvements to the Real Estate shall remain with the Seller until the Closing. In the event that the improvements are materially damaged prior to the Closing, the Buyer may terminate this Agreement.

6. Inspection and Disclosures:

a. The Buyer has personally inspected the Real Estate and is entering into this Agreement based on that inspection and not on any representations or warranties, express or implied, made by the Seller, except as otherwise provided for in this Agreement. The Buyer shall accept the Real Estate *as is* with all faults that exist on the date of this Agreement and at Closing.

b. The Seller agrees to deliver the Real Estate to the Buyer in its present condition, reasonable wear and depreciation excepted.

7. Seller's Representations:

The Seller makes not representation, warranties, or covenants regarding the Real Estate, its compliance with zoning and environmental laws, if any, or any physical condition of the Real Estate.

8. Expenses of Sale:

Buyer agrees to pay for any and all expenses of Closing, including title insurance premiums, lender's policy premiums, closing costs, recording fees, and documentary stamp taxes.

9. Default:

If either party shall default in the performance of this Agreement, the other party shall have all legal remedies available to them. Should the Buyer default, the parties agree the Seller may retain the Earnest Money Deposit as liquidated damages, which Earnest Money Deposit may not be the sole or exclusive remedy for the Buyer's breach.

10. General Provisions:

a. This Agreement shall not be assignable by either party without the consent of the other party.

b. This Agreement is binding upon and inures to the benefit of the parties and their respective successors and permitted assigns; provided, however, no assignment of all or any portion of this Agreement shall relieve any party of its obligations under this Agreement.

c. No waiver of any breach of any provision of this Agreement will be deemed a waiver of any other breach of this Agreement. No extension of time for performance of any act will be deemed an extension of the time for performance of any other act.

d. This Agreement may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which may be considered as an original.

e. This Agreement shall be construed according to the laws of Nebraska.

f. This Agreement contains the entire agreement of the Parties. This Agreement may be amended only in writing signed by all parties.



RESOLUTION - CLASSIFICATION AND COMPENSATION PLANS

The attached resolution will adopt the Classification and Compensation Plans that will be incorporated as a part of the 2023-24 FY budget. The Compensation Plan includes three categories: Exempt, Non-Exempt and Fire Employees. Additional information on the agreed-upon FOP (police) wage schedule is also included for reference.

The Classification Plan has the following changes from the most recent version approved by Council:

- **COLA:** Pay Grids reflect a 6% increase based on a cost of living adjustment.
- **FOP:** Police and Dispatch will receive a 3.25% increase which is the agreed upon amount from the October 5, 2022 contract.
- **Exempt:** The US Department of Labor is considering increasing the salary threshold for FLSA whit-collar overtime exemptions from \$35,568 to \$55,068. For employees to be classified as exempt they must meet both the duties test (Administrative, professional, Executive) and salary tests. It's expected that a decision is months away, however, depending on COLA these are the steps and positions that may be impacted. The City could choose to increase pay to meet the salary threshold or transfer the position to the nearest grade on the non-exempt grid.
 - Executive Admin/Tourism (\$53,560.00 -101/2)
 - All other positions on the 101,102, and 103 pay grades exceed that minimum amount. Action will only be necessary after a final decision is made
- **Non-exempt:** On 1/1/2024 Minimum Wage increases to \$12.00 per hour.
 - Missing steps are due to those steps being below the anticipated \$12.00/hour minimum wage which will go in to effect January 1, 2024.
 1. After COLA is adopted (effective 9/30/2023), any employee in these steps must be moved to the closest step being above \$12.00 effective 1/1/2024.
 2. This may impact 4 positions: Library Page, Museum Support Clerk, Nutrition Delivery Driver, and Nutrition Aide.
- **Fire:** Assistant Fire Chief moved to the exempt pay grid equal to the position of Police Lieutenant. This is being done as part of the succession planning which has taken place over the past two years.

It's expected that a decision is months away, however, depending on COLA these are the steps and positions that may be impacted. The City could choose to increase pay to meet the salary threshold or transfer the position to the nearest grade on the non-exempt grid.

Manufacturing Rate

Manufacturing Rate is \$1.442 per 100 cubic feet.

Industrial Park Rate

The Industrial Park Rate is \$1.611 per 100 cubic feet.

Municipal Rate

The Municipal Rate is \$1.206 per 100 cubic feet, and will not incur a monthly service charge for each account.

The City Council has received and reviewed the proposed changes and finds such changes to be in the best interest of the City of Alliance and should be therefore adopted pursuant to Sec. 28-448 and Sec. 28-449 of the Alliance Municipal Code. All is hereby amended with an effective date of this ordinance, in the following particulars:

The total sewer use charges shall consist of two (2) components: a Customer Charge and the Sewer Use Charge:

1. Customer Charge

a. Urban \$3.35 per month

Each residential, commercial and industrial user connected to the sewer system within the corporate limits of the City of Alliance, Nebraska.

b. Rural \$3.66 per month

Each residential, commercial and industrial user connected to the sewer system outside of the corporate limits of the City of Alliance, Nebraska.

2. Sewer Use Charge

a. Urban \$1.301 per 100 cubic feet of water used per month

b. Suburban \$1.434 per 100 cubic feet of water used per month

Customers that do not have an established sewer use charge will be charged the average sewer charge of other like users.

3. Sanitary Sewer Tap Fee

In order to recover labor and materials for tapping of lines, a tap fee in the amount of \$200.00 shall be charged at the time the City main is tapped.

Tap fees for lines greater than 4 inches will increase at \$50.00 per inch.

SECTION 5. All other ordinances, resolutions, or policies of the City of Alliance not consistent with the amendment made herein are hereby repealed. Provided, however, that the annual adjustment as set forth in Sec.28-263(b) and Sec. 28-449(g) of the Alliance Municipal Code shall not be repealed by this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall go into effect as upon its passage, approval, and publication according to law, provided that rate increases shall not take effect until October 1, 2023.
